Service Area 01 - South Island

- Q1. In reference to the Highway Maintenance Web Site/Yard Information Link/Yard Options Link/Maintenance Yard Status Document, Page 2/29 - 01 South Island Service Area Section - Strategic Yards to be Used in Next Round - Is the use of North Saanich (BCBC) mandatory?
- A. No it is not mandatory. If a contractor wanted to lease it they could. BCBC has indicated they will be updating their website with a rent price.**
- Q2. In reference to Amendment 1 for Service Area 1 - Volume 1, Chapter 3, Price Proposal Information, Article 1.3, Target Levels of Quantified Maintenance Services. Amendment 1 changed the target levels of quantified maintenance services and increased the estimate of cost for these services from \$3,935,852 to \$4,295,493. The upset price, however, did not change. Will the upset price be increased to reflect the change in target levels of Quantified Maintenance Services and if so, what will the new upset price be?
- A. The upset price was correct on the original RFP so it will not change.**
