Frequently Asked Questions

Service Area 07 (Fraser Valley)

Q1. With reference to Question 1, Dec 1, 2003, are there any other maintainable items that are not shown in report 2-8 that are yet to be inventoried and added to the listing of maintainable items? If so what are the items to be inventoried and possibly added to the inventory and will we be advised of the full inventory prior to RFP closing?

A. We are not aware of any missing inventories.

Q2. In your response to the Frequently Asked Questions regarding the Inventory Item Reflector Roadway, you have indicated that Service Area 07 is undergoing a complete re-inventory. Historically there have been approximately 625 lane kilometers of reflectors. Is it anticipated that this quantity of lane kilometers of surface reflectors will require placement, as there are virtually no roadway surface reflectors in place at present, and that subsequent maintenance of this quantity will be required? If this quantity of lane kms is incorrect, what is the lane kilometers of surface reflector placement and maintenance required?

A. It is not anticipated that these 625 lane kilometers will be replaced with surface mounted but they may be replaced with depressed or other delineation that will require maintenance.

Q3. Specified in SA-07 Local Area Specification #5 Rest Area Maintenance, is a requirement to provide maintenance services every 2 hours from April 1 to October 14 of each year. Is the requirement to provide the services every 2 hours needed around the clock (in other words, 24 hours per day) or is there a period of reduced usage of the facilities at Bradner and Cole Road Rest Areas when services are not required every 2 hours?

A. Service required from 0800 to 2000. The Local Area Specification will be changed accordingly before the contract is signed.
