

**TO BE USED TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF LONG WHEELBASE TRUCK TRACTORS IN COMBINATION WITH SEMI-TRAILERS**

1. This permit is **NOT** valid for tridem drive axle truck tractors.
2. This permit is **NOT** valid to transport any oversize/overweight loads. These vehicles are not permitted to transport any oversize/overweight loads at any time; there are no additional permits available.
3. This permit **IS** valid for the following dimensional limits as outlined below:

**i) TRUCK TRACTOR and SEMI-TRAILER**

Single trip or term oversize permits may be issued for long wheelbase tractors exceeding 6.2 metres (244") in combination with semi-trailers manufactured after August 31, 1988, up to a maximum overall length of 23 metres in overall length for a truck-tractor/semi-trailer combination provided the trailer wheelbase is reduced according the chart below.

**ii) TRUCK TRACTOR and SEMI-TRAILER (Necessary Coupling)**

Single trip or term permits may be issued to long wheelbase truck-tractors that cannot be separated from the semi-trailer (e.g. generator on the truck-tractor necessary for trailer operation such as show tour two vehicle combinations) up to 23 metres in overall length without the requirement for reducing the semi-trailer wheelbase.

**iii) TRUCK TRACTOR in an A, B, or C TRAIN CONFIGURATION**

Single trip or term permits may be issued to long wheelbase truck-tractors in an A, B, or C Train configuration up to 23 metres in overall length. The reduction in semi-trailer wheelbase is not applicable in this case as the maximum wheelbases can never be achieved.

4. This permit **IS** valid anytime including Sundays and Holidays.
5. No other exceptions are expressed or implied with respect to the *Commercial Transport Act or Regulations*.  
*For example: effective rear overhang of semi-trailer must not exceed 35% of semi-trailer wheelbase*
