Bulletin 13 – Single Trip Non-Resident Permits

1. It has also been learned that quite a number of furniture moving vans are not owned by the company whose name appears on the van, e.g., Aero, Mayflower.
2. In order to alleviate this problem, the following procedure is to be followed when issuing single-trip Non-Resident Permits:
 - (a) VAN LINE TRUCK: Check the registration and issue permit in the name of the owner. Do not issue the permit in the name of the company whose name is painted on the sides of the van, i.e., ALLIED VAN LINES unless ALLIED VAN LINES is in fact the registered owner.
 - (b) RENTAL TRUCKS: Issue the N.R.P. indicating both the registered owner and lessee including full address.
 - (c) GENERAL INTER-PROVINCIAL HAULERS: Issue N.R.P. in the name of the company or individual in whose name the truck is licensed or registered.
