The <u>BC Taxi Camera Rule</u> identifies licensees that must have a working, PT Board-approved camera in each taxi in the fleet. Companies with a Passenger Transportation (PT) Licence to operate taxis must, as a term and condition of the licence, comply with this rule. ¹ The Registrar of Passenger Transportation <u>requires that taxi companies</u> submit a <u>Taxi Camera Equipment</u> <u>Compliance Declaration</u> (Form PTR5016) with their annual licence renewal, and any time on request.
