# Passenger Transportation Board Bulletin

To do this, the applicant is proposing the following amendments: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Add the City of Nanaimo as a route point for Route 2.</li><li>• Revise the "Limited Pick Up &amp; Drop Off" term and condition for Route 2.</li><li>• Revise the "Route Overlap" term and condition which relates to Routes 1 and 2.</li><li>• No changes are proposed for Route 3 or any of the following terms and conditions: engaged carrier authorization, service, schedule, or express authorization.</li></ul> <p>The applicant claims that its application proposes no reduction in minimum route frequency.</p>	February 7, 2008

### **Submissions:**

Any person may make a submission on an application to the Passenger Transportation Board. Submissions should relate to the following matters that the Board must consider (see section 28 of the Passenger Transportation Act):

- (a) *whether there is a public need for the service the applicant proposes to provide under any special authorization;*
- (b) *whether the applicant is a fit and proper person to provide that service and is capable of providing that service; and*
- (c) *whether the application, if granted, would promote sound economic conditions in the passenger transportation business in British Columbia.*

All submissions must be:

- *in writing*
- *accompanied by a \$50 fee (payable only by cheque or money order to the Minister of Finance)*
- *received at the Passenger Transportation Board office in Victoria by 4:30 p.m. within 15 days of the PT Board Bulletin publication date (10 days for Change of Rates applications).*

All information that a person submits on an application is routinely disclosed by the Board to the applicant. Any person who gathers and submits personal information from third parties is subject to the Personal Information Protection Act and should not guarantee the confidentiality of the information being submitted. Within 10 days of when a submission is forwarded by the Board to the applicant, the applicant may reply by sending written comments to the Board.
