1. Industry Updates & Advisories

Licence District Review – Update for Lower Mainland Limousines

In November, 2010, board staff sent proposed amended terms and conditions of licence to limousine companies operating in the Greater Vancouver Regional District (GVRD), Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) and Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (SLRD) that have “licence districts” (e.g.: LD 9, 9A, 14, 14A or 15) included in their operating area.

Pursuant to Section 31 of the *Passenger Transportation Act*, the Board is now directing the Registrar to amend the terms and conditions of those licenses affected in the GVRD, FVRD and SLRD.
