New Deadline for TOP Application Submissions: March 3, 2011

Four Vancouver taxi companies are applying for Temporary Operating Permits (TOPs). They want to operate a total of 65 additional taxis for up to 92 (non-consecutive) days from April 1 – October 1, 2011. Vehicles would operate on Friday and Saturday evenings (3 pm – 6 am), and on “black” and “red” days at cruise ship terminals, and other special days.
