Lower Mainland taxis must have a Taxi Identification Code by June 16, 2014.

The Passenger Transportation Board is implementing a taxi identification plan. By June 2014, each taxi in the Greater Vancouver Regional District must have a unique taxi identification code (TIC) on the outside and inside of the vehicle.
