Update on Flat Rates for Whistler-YVR Limousine Trips

Some licensees expressed concern that implementing the proposed minimum flat rates on November 12 would affect pre-sold limousine services. The Board is clarifying that a transition period would apply. The deadline for comment on the proposed rates remains October 31, 2014.
