Limousine Regulation Change: Perimeter Seating Buses

New licensing requirements apply to stretch limousines and limo buses that seat 12 or more passengers (perimeter seating buses). These vehicles cannot be operated under a General Authorization licence after April 30, 2015. Details are posted on the Board's web page for [Perimeter Seating Buses \(PSBs\)](#).
