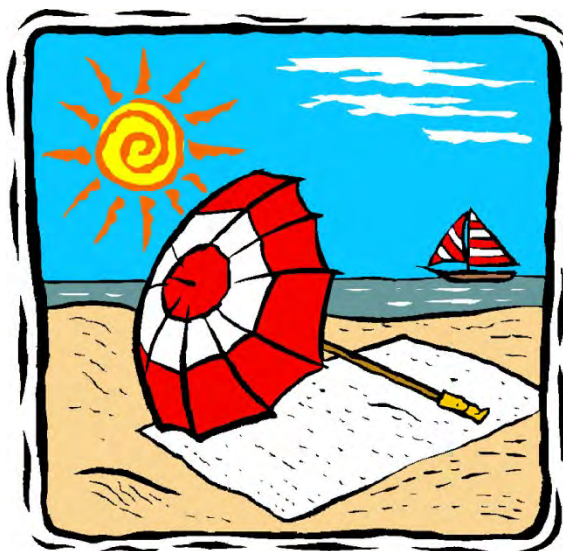


Passenger Transportation Board Weekly Bulletin
