T	2 – 7	<u>Taxis</u> Vehicle operations would be classified as a taxicab if licensees: a) Charge metered rates and have Board authorization to use a taxi meter, or b) Charge non-metered rates and have a licence that contains express authorization to use a top light or pick up hails and flags from the street, and operate one or more vehicles that carry no more than 7 passengers.
SL	3 – 5	<u>Sedan Limos</u> Vehicles must bear a National Safety Mark or Compliance Label as a passenger car under the Canada Motor Safety Act that has 4 passenger doors, a closed body and a wheel base of not less than 113 inches (287.02 cm).
LV	6 – 11	<u>Large Passenger Directed Vehicles</u> E.g. Limousines, larger passenger vans, sport utility vehicles, etc.
M	1-2	<u>Motorcycles</u> Vehicle must be a motorcycle as defined by the <i>Motor Vehicle Act</i>
