

# WILDLIFE WARNING SIGNS PROGRAM

## Overview

The Ministry's standard leaping stag wildlife warning signs are the least expensive form of wildlife-vehicle accident mitigation measure at approximately \$150 per sign. Unfortunately, it appears that there is a low correlation between the reduction of accidents and the presence of wildlife warning signs. Swedish research has found that the signs were not noticed by 60% of motorists.
