Suggestions to help detect possible Impersonation

Listed in no particular order:

1. Request registration.
2. Ask questions about address.
3. Ask whose vehicle it is.
4. What is the Registered Owner's (R/O's) address?
5. Ask for driver's full name.
6. Get telephone number. Ask OCC dispatcher to call number and ask for him/her or if they know the person stopped (sometimes the person stopped gives a false name and the actual person will answer the phone).
7. Check the information given on system.
8. If the vehicle's R/O is not the same as person stopped, DL on register, run it on system.
9. Make a detailed physical description, e.g., tattoos, marks, scars.
10. Keep extensive notes either in notebook, or better, on ticket's officer note portion.
11. Query drivers license newer 10-27 (drivers license check) have description on them.
12. Ask place of birth.
13. Ask about drivers record, recent tickets etc.
14. Obtain driver license history.
15. Follow up with registered owner to identify.
16. Get the offender to sign the ticket.
17. Keep in mind your gut feeling.
18. If a camera is available, photograph driver for evidentiary purposes.

CHARTER OF RIGHTS

Sec. 10(a) ... I am arresting/detaining you for
(*State reason for arrest/detention, including the offence and provide known information about the offence, including date and place.*)

Sec. 10(b) ... It is my duty to inform you that you have the right to retain and instruct counsel in private, without delay. You may call any lawyer you want.

There is a 24-hour telephone service available which provides a legal aid duty lawyer who can give you legal advice in private. This advice is given without charge and the lawyer can explain the legal aid plan to you.

If you wish to contact a legal aid duty lawyer, I can provide you with a telephone number.

Do you understand? Do you want to call a lawyer?

SUPPLEMENTARY CHARTER WARNING

(If an arrested or detained person initially indicated that he or she wished to contact legal counsel and then subsequently indicates that he or she no longer wishes to exercise the right to counsel, read the following additional charter warning.)

You have the right to a reasonable opportunity to contact counsel. I am obliged not to take a statement from you or to ask you to participate in any process which could provide incriminating evidence until you are certain about whether you want to exercise this right.

Do you understand? What do you wish to do?

SECONDARY WARNING

(Name), you are detained with respect to: (reason for detainment). If you have spoken to any police officer (including myself) with respect to this matter, who has offered to you any hope of advantage or suggested any fear of prejudice should you speak or refuse to speak with me(us) at this time, it is my duty to warn you that no such offer or suggestion can be of any effect and must not influence you or make you feel compelled to say anything to me(us) for any reason, but anything you do say may be used in evidence.

WRITTEN STATEMENT CAUTION

I have been advised by: (investigating officer) that I am not obliged to say anything, but anything I do say may be given in evidence. I understand the meaning of the foregoing and I choose to make the following statement.

APPROVED SCREENING DEVICE

(ASD) DEMAND

In accordance with the provisions of the Criminal Code, I hereby demand that you provide a sample of your breath, forthwith, suitable for analysis using and approved screening device.

OFFICIAL WARNING

**"YOU ARE NOT OBLIGED TO SAY ANYTHING,
BUT ANYTHING YOU DO SAY MAY BE
GIVEN IN EVIDENCE."**

BREATH DEMAND

I have reasonable grounds to believe that you are committing, or within the preceding three hours have, as a result of consumption of alcohol, committed an offence under Section 253 of the Criminal Code, and I hereby demand that you provide, as soon as practical, such samples of your breath as are necessary to enable a proper analysis to be made to determine the concentration, if any, of alcohol in your blood and to accompany me for the purpose of enabling such samples to be taken.

BLOOD DEMAND

I have reasonable grounds to believe that you are committing, or within the preceding three hours have, as a result of consumption of alcohol, committed an offence under Section 253 of the Criminal Code, and I hereby demand that you provide, as soon as practical, such samples of your blood as are necessary to enable a proper analysis to be made to determine the concentration, if any, of alcohol in your blood.

Samples of your blood will be taken by, or under the direction of a qualified medical practitioner who is satisfied that the taking of those samples will not endanger you or your health.

SFST DEMAND

(Standard Field Sobriety Tests)

Section 254(2)

In accordance with the provisions of the Criminal Code, I demand that you perform forthwith physical coordination tests and to accompany me for the purpose of performing such tests. Do you understand?

DRE DEMAND
(Drug recognition Expert)
Section 254 (3.1)

I demand that you submit, as soon as practical, to an evaluation conducted by an evaluation officer to determine whether your ability to operate a motor vehicle is impaired by a drug or by a combination of a drug and alcohol, and that you accompany me for this purpose.

Do you understand?

EVALUATOR DEMANDS
Section 254 (3.4)
Bodily Substance

(1) (Urine or oral fluid - Section 254(3.4)(a))

I demand that you provide, as soon as practical a sample of your urine (OR oral fluid) that will enable a proper analysis to be made to determine whether you have a drug in your body. Do you understand?

or

(2) (Blood - Section 2254 (3.4)(b))

I demand that you provide, as soon as practical, such samples of your blood that will enable a proper analysis to be made to determine whether you have a drug in your body. Blood samples will be taken only by or under the direction of a qualified medical practitioner and if the qualified medical practitioner is satisfied that the taking of the samples will not endanger your life or health. Do you understand?

DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT

Approved Instrument Demand Section 254 (3.3)

As an evaluation officer, I demand that you provide, as soon as practical, a sample of your breath that, in my opinion, will enable a proper analysis to be made by means of an approved instrument. Do you understand?

MVA Section 90.3 - 12 hour licence suspension

I have reasonable and probable grounds to believe:

1) you have alcohol in your body

or

2) you have failed or refused to comply with the demand to provide a sample of breath that is necessary to enable a proper analysis of your breath to be made by means of an approved screening device.

I therefore, direct you to surrender your driver's license. Your license to drive is now suspended for a period of 12 hours from this time and date.

MVA Section 215 - 24 Hour Roadside Prohibition

I have reasonable and probable grounds to believe that your ability to drive a motor vehicle is affected by alcohol (or by drug), and I therefore, direct you to surrender your driver's licence.

You are now prohibited from driving a motor vehicle for a period of 24 hours from this time and date.

(for alcohol, if breath test not already administered) However, if you do not accept this prohibition, you have a right to forthwith request a blood alcohol test to determine your blood alcohol level. In the event the test indicates that your blood alcohol level does not exceed 50 milligrams of alcohol in 100 millilitres of blood, this prohibition from driving is terminated.

(for drug) However, if you do not accept this prohibition, you have a right to attempt to satisfy a peace officer having charge of this matter that your ability to drive a motor vehicle is not affected by a drug other than alcohol, and if the peace officer is so satisfied this prohibition from driving is terminated.

MINIMUM VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

1. All Vehicles – General

- Valid Class Drivers licence.
- Must conform to MVA & MVAR.
- Valid Insurance or Permit. Licence plate on rear and/or front
- Vehicles over 2.3 metres wide or 10 passengers must carry reflective warning device.

2. Private Passenger Vehicles

- All items in number 1.
- ICBC validation decal on rear plate.

3. Passenger Transportation Licensed Vehicles

- All items in number 1.
- Valid C.V.I.P. decal displayed.
- Copy of C.V.I.P. Inspection Report.
- Carrier name/number displayed on sides.
- Valid Passenger Transportation License Plate on Front.
- Valid Carrier Certificate,.
- Conditions of Passenger Transportation license.
- Carrier name and/or reference number on registration.
- National Safety Code number on registration.

4. Commercial Motor Vehicles

- All items in number 1. If Passenger Transportation licensed, all items in number 3
- Valid permit if licensed out of province and not subject to CAVR.
- ICBC valid decal on front licence plate, over 5,500 kg.
- National Safety Code number on registration, over 5,000 kg.
- Name of NSC holder displayed on both sides, over 5,500 kg.
- Carrier records driver duty status, cycle and hours for each day even if driver exempt from log book
- Log book required if over 160 km radius of home depot.
- Pre-trip inspection if over 14,600 kg or 3 or more axles.

MINIMUM VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

5. Vehicles Over 8,200 kg

- All items in number 1 and 4.
- If Passenger Transportation licensed, all items in number 3.
- Valid C.V.I.P. decal displayed.

6. Trailers

- Valid licence, insurance or permit.
- Operating brakes Div. 5 or 6 MVAR if over 1,400 kg..
- Valid C.V.I.P. decal over 1,400 kg (some exceptions).
- Operating breakaway device on brakes over 1,400 kg.
- Driver controlled brakes in tow vehicle over 2,800 kg.

7. Vehicles Carrying Dangerous Goods

- All items in number 1, other items as required.
- Valid Training/Handling Certificate (driver).
- Shipping Documents within reach, vehicle placards as required.

8. Buses (all)

- All items in number 1, other items as required.
- If Passenger Transportation licensed, all items in number 3.
- Valid C.V.I.P. decal displayed.
- Copy of C.V.I.P. Inspection Report.
- Completed Pre-Trip Inspection Report.
- Reflective warning devices.

Trailer/Towed Vehicle Brake Exemptions (MVAR 5.02(3)):

- a. On 1 axle of house trailer with more than 2 axles, on any axle of trailer
- b. If licensed GVW of trailer is 1,400 kg or less AND, is less than 50% of licensed GVW of towing trailer
- c. On any axle of towing dolly towed by motor vehicle where: aggregate net weight of towing dolly and gross weight of the towed vehicle (one axle on tow dolly) does not exceed 1,400 kgs OR, motor vehicle towing the towing dolly has a GVW rating in excess of the aggregate of:
 - net weight of towing dolly
 - the GVW of the motor vehicle one axle of which is being carried by the towing dolly, and
 - the GVW of the motor vehicle towing the towing dolly.

Vehicle Brake Exemptions (MVAR 5.04(1)):

- d. On any axle of a motor vehicle where 1 axle is being carried by towing dolly,
- e. On any axle of a trailer consisting of a piece of construction machinery towed by a truck where the truck GVWR exceeds the aggregate of the gross vehicle weights of the trailer and truck
- f. Implements of Husbandry

Vehicle Brake Exemptions (MVAR 5.04(1))

- g. special mobile vehicles, any chassis w/o body or load, and
- h. motor vehicles originally manufactured and designed without brakes

NOTE: Motor vehicles towed by motor homes exempt brakes if the towed motor vehicle weighs less than 2,000 kg and is less than 40% of the GVW rate of the motor home towing it via a tow bar (MVAR 5.02(7)).

- The gross vehicle weight of the motor vehicle, one axle of which is being carried by the towing dolly, plus
- The gross vehicle weight of the motor vehicle towing the dolly is greater than the gross vehicle weight rating of the motor vehicle towing the dolly.
