STEP 2

You will be required to carry and provide evidence of General Liability Insurance with inclusive limits of not less than \$2,000,000 (two million dollars) for litter pickup, weeding planting, and non-toxic invasive plant spotting and reporting, and not less than \$5,000,000 (five million dollars) for mowing.

Please provide a copy of your organization's Certificate of Insurance to the program coordinator.

STEP 3

Each Volunteer must sign a Waiver.

All volunteers for the Adopt a Highway Program must complete and sign the "Waiver and Acknowledgement of Risk" form H1115B.

Please provide a list of the name(s) of the individuals to the program coordinator.

Note: Volunteers between 12-18 years must have their waiver signed by a parent or guardian.
