TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAM

Weigh2GoBC ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the Weigh2GoBC program, carriers must be base plated and licensed in British Columbia or base plated in Washington State and prorate licensed into British Columbia.

Pre-Requisites

Prior to registering a transponder in the Weigh2GoBC program a carrier must:

- 1. Have a valid Business BCeID account (available through www.bceid.ca);
- 2. Have a National Safety Code number for BC carriers or a U.S. DOT number for WA carriers;
- 3. Have a valid ASTM-6 transponder (available from the Weigh2GoBC Administrator);
- 4. Have available to upload a color digital picture (jpeg) of the commercial motor vehicle that you are registering¹;
- 5. Be able to provide certain commercial vehicle information including plate number for each vehicle being registered;
- 6. Review the terms and conditions and sign this document to accept them; and
- Submit a completed application form including National Safety Code/U.S. DOT number, carrier name, contact telephone number and email address.

PROGRAM APPLICATION

Application can be made in one of the following ways:

- Online applications can be completed through the Weigh2GoBC website at www.Weigh2GoBC.ca
- Washington carriers must call the Transponder Administrator at 250-953-4001
- Manual applications can be submitted by faxing both sides of this completed Application Form to the Weigh2GoBC Administrator at 250-952-0578. Please note: A valid BCeID is still required if submitting a manual application.

The picture must be a clear image taken from the front right side so that both the front and right side of the tractor are shown (the trailer is not required). Ensure there are no other trucks or people in the photo. Photos must be a minimum of 640x480.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

- 1. A transponder must only be installed in the commercial motor vehicle identified in the Weigh2GoBC system;
- 2. To transfer a transponder to another vehicle, you must de-register the transponder from the existing vehicle and re-register the transponder to the new vehicle. Non-compliance with this policy may result in any of the sanctions set out below;
- 3. A carrier or their designate must immediately update the Weigh2GoBC system of any commercial motor vehicle licence plate, contact name, telephone number or email address change;
- 4. A green light on the transponder allows your vehicle(s) to by-pass an open Inspection Station;
- 5. If the Inspection Station is closed, your vehicle may bypass the Inspection Station;
- 6. A red light or no light on the transponder requires that if the Inspection Station is open you are required to report to the Inspection Station;
- 7. Failure to stop at an open Inspection Station when the transponder indicates a red light or no light may result in the driver being charged under the Commercial Transport Act Regulation section 7.03(2) "Bypass Weigh scale";
- 8. Lost, stolen or inoperative transponders must be immediately reported to the Weigh2GoBC Administrator;
- 9. You agree to allow a Peace Officer to inspect your commercial motor vehicle transponder upon demand;
- 10. You understand and accept that failure to follow these Terms and Conditions may result in your vehicles' transponders becoming de-registered from the Weigh2GoBC program so that all your fleet vehicles will have to report to every open BC Inspection Station; and
- 11. The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure reserves the right to use encounter data information from the Weigh2GoBC program to support all Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement programs, and your signature below authorizes this use of information.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Membership in the Weigh2GoBC program does not guarantee an automatic by-pass at participating Inspection Stations;
- Upon registration, the Weigh2GoBC system will assign you a "Random Report Percentage" (RRP) which determines how
 frequently you will be randomly directed to report. This is based on your National Safety Code rating, intervention level and
 on-road performance. (Note: Compliant performance will result in a more favourable RRP being achieved over time);
- The Weigh2GoBC Administrator will review each Weigh2GoBC application to ensure the correct RRP has been assigned:
- Non-compliance with the Weigh2GoBC terms and conditions may result in an increase in your RRP, de-registration of your vehicle transponder and/or de-registration of your fleet from the Weigh2GoBC program
- The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure is currently providing a limited number of free transponders to each carrier, however, it is not obligated to continue to do so.

THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE ("THE MINISTRY") IS PROVIDING A TRANSPONDER (OR A NUMBER OF TRANSPONDERS) TO THE CARRIER AT NO COST, BUT DOES NOT PROVIDE ANY WARRANTEE OR GUARANTEE REGARDING ITS (THEIR) OPERATION OR CONTINUED OPERATION.
