

CONFIRMATION OF MANDATORY MINIMUM ROTARY WING AIRCRAFT, EQUIPMENT AND PILOT QUALIFICATIONS

DESCRIPTION	Confirmation of Certification or Approvals
1. All aircraft are equipped with narrow banded VHF-FM avionics for all radio frequencies	
2. All aircraft are equipped with a handheld, programmable, portable VHF-FM radio	
3. All aircraft are equipped with automated GPS flight following	
4. All light, intermediate and medium helicopters are equipped with Transport Canada approved shoulder harnesses for all passenger seats	
5. All aircraft are equipped with a Global Positioning System (GPS)	
6. All aircraft are equipped with refueling gear	
7. All aircraft are equipped with a long line capability of One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet (complete with remote hook preferred)	
8. Two nets for heli-sling loads	
The mandatory minimum rotary wing flying experience and qualifications to be completed for each pilot.	
MANDATORY MINIMUM FOR ROTARY WING PILOTS	Confirmation of Minimums
Mountain Flying Competency	
Mountain Flying Currency — Pilot must maintain a minimum of 100 hours of flight in mountainous regions (as defined by Transport Canada's Aeronautical Information Manual) within the last 12 months	
3. External Load —Long Line (vertical reference), Precision Load Placement	
4. Hover Exit	
5 Confined Area Operations	
6. Pilot has greater than 3,000 hours total PIC time: a. One Hundred (100) hours total PIC time is required by aircraft category flown (i.e.light, intermediate, medium or heavy); and b. One Hundred (100) hours PIC time is required on the specific model of aircraft being flown	
Further job specific activities may require pilot competencies in the following:
