Festive Season TOP (FS TOP) Policy	<p>Section 38 of the Passenger Transportation Act authorizes the Board to approve temporary permit applications if the Board considers that there is a temporary and urgent need for a licensee to increase its fleet size.</p> <p>November 15th through January 15th is typically the busiest period of the year for taxis in the province. There may be a <i>temporary and urgent need</i> for taxi companies to operate more vehicles at this time. The Board streamlines application TOP processes during the Festive Season.</p> <p>Taxi companies may apply for FS TOPs to increase their maximum fleet of <u>full-time vehicles</u> (e.g. vehicles that may operate 24 / 7) by 10% or by 1 vehicle, whichever is greater. (Percentages are calculated with conventional rounding.)</p>

Terms & Conditions:	
Service 1	<i>The following terms and conditions apply to Service 1:</i>
Originating Area:	Transportation of passengers may originate from any point in the City of Nelson or within 48 road kilometres of the boundary of the City of Nelson.
Destination Area:	Transportation of passengers may terminate at any point in British Columbia.
Return Trips:	The same passengers may be returned from where their trip terminates in the <i>destination area</i> to any point in the <i>originating area</i> if the return trip is arranged by the time the originating trip terminates.
Express authorizations:	(i) Vehicles may be equipped with a meter that calculates fares on a time and distance basis. (ii) Vehicles may be equipped with a top light. (iii) Vehicles may pick up passengers who hail or flag the motor vehicle from the street.
Service 2	<i>The following terms and conditions apply to Service 2:</i>
Originating Area:	Transportation of passengers may originate from any point in the City of Nelson.
Destination Area:	Transportation of passengers may terminate at any point on the Canadian Pacific rail line within 193 road kilometres of the boundary of the City of Nelson.
Return Trips:	The same passengers may be returned from where their trip terminates in the <i>destination area</i> to any point in the <i>originating area</i> if the return trip is arranged by the time the originating trip terminates.
Express authorizations:	(i) Vehicles may be equipped with a meter that calculates fares on a time and distance basis. (ii) Vehicles may be equipped with a top light. (iii) Vehicles may pick up employees of Canadian Pacific Railway Ltd. and its heirs and assigns who hail or flag the motor vehicle from the street.
Service Limitations:	Service may be provided only to employees of Canadian Pacific Railway Ltd. and its heirs and assigns only as long as a current written contract exists between the licence holder and Canadian Pacific Railway Ltd. and its heirs and assigns, and as long as the Passenger Transportation Board has received and approved the rates.

Service 3:	<i>The following terms and conditions apply to Service 3:</i>
Originating Area:	Transportation of passengers may originate from any point the City of Nelson.
Destination Area:	Transportation of passengers may terminate at any point in the City of Nelson.
Return Trips:	The same passengers may be returned from where their trip terminates in the destination area to any point in the originating area if the return trip is arranged by the time the originating trip terminates.
Transfer of a permit:	This special authorization may not be assigned or transferred except with the approval of the Board pursuant to section 30 of the Passenger Transportation Act.
Permit Expiry:	This permit expires on January 15, 2019 at 11:59 p.m.

Rates:	<p>The rates approved by the Board as of December 1, 2018 apply to the vehicle operating under this permit.</p> <p>Standard Board Rules for Charging Taxicab Rates of November 16, 2016 apply to this permit.</p>
